



She is currently pursuing a master's degree in Leadership through Southern Nazarene University. To say she is passionate about reentry is an understatement, and she loves finding common ground and grace over delicious meals, outdoor adventures, and inspirational art!

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DHS FATHERHOOD INITIATIVE

Description:

DHS has a new fatherhood initiative that's helping build and maintain family connections throughout Oklahoma. In this session there will be a discussion about Fatherhood, why it's important, and the effects of absent Fathers.

FLYNN MASON

Flynn graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Hotel & Restaurant Administration from OSU. In 2009, after 7 years in hotel management, he joined DHS as a Social Service Specialist. He found his calling whenever he started working with DHS's TANF unit in 2012. He became a Career Development Specialist in 2015 and was the first CDS/case worker, helping the TANF unit move into a centralized unit.
